SERVICES:

WHAT WE BELIEVE

THE BIBLE

The sole basis of our belief is the Bible, which is uniquely God-inspired, without error, and the final authority on all matters on which it bears. As the Bible teaches, there is one God, eternally existing in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit ...each possessing all the attributes of Deity.

We believe that all of Scripture originated from God and that it was revealed to individuals chosen specifically for that purpose. Scripture speaks with the authority of God, while reflecting the backgrounds, styles, and vocabularies of the human authors. We hold that the Scriptures, in their original manuscript, are the unique, full, and final authority on all matters of faith and practice, and there are no other writings similarly inspired by God.

GOD the FATHER

God created humans to have fellowship with Him, but they defied God by sinfully going their own way. As a result, we need God's saving grace to end our alienation from Him. Salvation comes only through God's grace - not human effort - and must be received personally by repentance and faith.

JESUS CHRIST – GOD THE SON

Jesus Christ, second Person of the Trinity, lived a sinless life on earth and voluntarily paid for our sin by dying on the cross as our substitute. This accomplished salvation for all who receive grace by trusting in Him alone. He rose from the dead and is the only mediator between God and us. He baptizes believers in the Holy Spirit. He will return to earth to consummate history.

THE HOLY SPIRIT – GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit draws sinners to Christ and equips believers for personal growth and service to the church. The Holy Spirit will always guide us to truth. In the Book of Acts, they were all together in one accord. Armed with this information, you will have a good reason to seek God concerning this subject. And when you seek Him, He will respond. Get ready, for you are about to be empowered.

“And when the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a noise like a violent, rushing wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them tongues as of fire distributing themselves, and they rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began TO SPEAK WITH OTHER TONGUES, AS THE SPIRIT WAS GIVING THEM UTTERANCE.” Acts 2:1-4

This experience will bring you to an entirely new level of Christian living. When you gave your life to Christ, you were filled with the Spirit, but the baptism of the Holy Spirit is a totally different experience, separate and apart from being born again. It is an overflowing, a bubbling over that comes to the believer, and it further enriches the Christian experience in many varied ways.

OUR LIFESTYLE STATEMENT...WHAT WE PRACTICE

Beliefs are not worth much unless they are translated into actions. Based on what the Bible teaches, we feel very strongly about the following practices:

Jesus Christ is the head of our church.

"Christ is the head of his Body, the church. He is the source of the Body's life..." Ephesians 4:15, 16

Christ is the recognized head of our church, not any person, group, or religious organization. While recognizing the value of associating and cooperating with other groups of Christians, we believe every local church should be self-governing and independent from any denominational control. In relating to "daughter churches" that we sponsor, we will encourage each congregation to determine its own strategy, structure, and style.

Every believer is a minister.

"Christ loves us, and by his death he has freed us from our sins and made us a kingdom of priests to serve God..." Revelation 1:6 (GN)

"You are...the King's priests...God's own people, chosen to proclaim the wonderful acts of God." 1 Peter 2:9 (GN)

The Bible teaches that every Christian is called to "full time" Christian service, regardless of his or her vocation. We practice the truth that every believer is a minister by encouraging every member to find a place of service and ministry. Every believer has direct access to God through prayer and Bible reading.

DARE TO BELIEVE GOD! THE GENESIS OF GRACE UNLIMITED...

Grace Unlimited International Church is a earthly manifestation of the intentions of God toward in People in this hour. Grace Unlimited was a strategic and divinely ordained merger of the Kingdom Life Center Church International founded by Bishop Quacy L. Smith (*founded October 10, 2010*) and the Heritage Christian of San Diego, founded by Bishop Dennis Leonard (*Founded April 24, 2011*). After Bishop Leonard announced his return to Denver, Colorado to rebirth Heritage Christian Center in Colorado, he searched out a man of God who could lead the people of God in the San Diego church he had organized. After due diligence and prayer, the mantle of leadership fell to Bishop Quacy L. Smith to take the ministry to the next level.

After assuming the helm of leadership, Bishop Smith sought the Lord for several months until he received direction from the Lord to merge the two ministries together to for a new global movement of Grace for this generation. Bishop Smith presented the word of the Lord and the strategic plans and objectives before the leadership at the both campuses and received the unanimous support. From this divine moment...the Global Grace movement began! WE are well on our way to fulfilling the vision of God for the local campuses and the territory to which God has assigned us to perfume the planet with the Gospel of Grace and to ensure that our church campuses remain...the place of GRACE! A place where whoever can be healed of whatever!

COMMUNION

The Meaning of the Lord's Supper

Jesus never asked His disciples to remember His birth. But He did instruct them to remember His death and resurrection. He gave the church two visible symbols (called "ordinances") as reminders of His death. These two ordinances are: Baptism and The Lord's Supper. The Lord's Supper is an object lesson that represents a great spiritual truth for believers.

What is the Lord's Supper? (1 Cor. 11:23-26)

1. It is a **SIMPLE ACT**
"The Lord Jesus, on the night He was betrayed, took bread..." (vs. 23)
2. It is a **REMINDER**

“...and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, ‘This is my body, which is for you; eat it in remembrance of me.’” (vs. 24)

3. It is a **SYMBOL**

“In the same way, He took the cup, saying, ‘This cup is the new covenant in my blood; drink it to remember me.’” (vs. 25)

4. It is a **STATEMENT OF FAITH**

“For whenever you eat the bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes back.” (vs. 26)

When receiving the Lord's Supper...

1. Examine Your Life - 1 Corinthians 11:27
2. Confessing Your Sins - 1 John 1:9
3. Recommit Yourself - Romans 12:1
4. Restore Broken Relationships - Matthew 5:23-24

WATER BAPTISM

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING WATER BAPTIZED:

Why Should I be Baptized:

1. To Follow the Example Set By **JESUS**.

"At that time Jesus came from Nazareth and was baptized by John in the river." Mark 1:9

2. Because Christ **COMMANDS** it.

*"Jesus said, 'Go then, to all people everywhere and **make them my disciples**, baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and **then teach them** to obey everything I have commanded you.'" Matt. 28:19-20*

3. It demonstrates that I really am a **BELIEVER**.

*"...many of the people who heard Him **believed** and were **baptized**." Acts 18:8*

"We know that we have come to know Him, if we obey His commands." 1 John 2:3

WHAT IS THE MEANING OF BAPTISM?

1. It illustrates Christ's **DEATH** and resurrection.

"Christ died for our sins... He was buried...and He rose again." 1 Cor. 15:3-4

*"For when you are **baptized**, you were **buried** with Christ, and in baptism you were also **raised** with Christ. Col. 2:12*

2. It illustrates my **NEW LIFE** as a Christian.

“When someone becomes a Christian he becomes a brand new person inside. The old life has passed away and a new life has begun!” 2 Cor. 5:17

*“**By our baptism then**, we were buried with Him and shared His death, in order that, just as Christ was **raised** from the dead...so also **we may live a new life!**” Rom. 6:4*

Baptism doesn't make you a believer — it shows that **you already believe**. Baptism does not “save” you, only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring — it's the outward symbol of the commitment you made in your heart.

*“For it is by grace you have been saved, **through faith**...it is the gift of God — not by works, so that no one can boast.” Ephesians 2:8-9*

Can My Family Be Baptized Together?

Yes! If each family member understands fully the meaning of baptism, and each one has personally placed his/her trust in Christ for salvation, we encourage families to be baptized at the same time. It is a wonderful expression of commitment. **Young children must have accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior prior to the baptismal.** However, it is important to remember that baptism is a **personal** statement of faith, not a family tradition. It is usually not wise to delay your baptism while waiting on other family members to accept Christ, particularly children. This puts an undue pressure on them, and delays your **obedience**.

What Should I Wear when I am Baptized?

Women should wear dark shorts and a top or a “mumuu” style dress rather than a swimsuit. Men should wear a t-shirt and dark shorts or modest swim-trunks. Bring a change of clothes, a towel, and a plastic bag for your wet clothes. We provide changing rooms.

What if I was Baptized as a Child?

Baptism is for those who have made a personal decision to trust Christ alone for their salvation. If you were baptized as a child, it was the intent of your parents that you would one day be a follower of Christ. Your Baptism as an adult can be viewed as the fulfillment of your parents' wishes. It in no way repudiates the Baptism you received as a child.

Baby Dedication

As a church family, we celebrate with the family of the newborn child. During the Baby Dedication Service, all of the newborns and their family members are asked to come forward and each baby is individually prayed for and dedicated unto the Lord. All family members are welcome to come forward and photos can be taken during the time your baby is prayed over. The family and baby are given a "Baby's First Bible" as a gift from Bishop Leonard and Mrs. Leonard. Upcoming Baby Dedication dates are listed in the weekly bulletin. THE GROWTH TRACK

8 KEYS TO YOUR SPIRITUAL GROWTH SUCCESS

1. Make New Friends

Be friendly, say hello and smile when passing people. Offer to carry something when you see someone is struggling...open the door for someone...stop and pray for someone when you know they're overwhelmed and finally, offer compliments! You never know what the person next to you is going through...be that special someone that shows they care

2. Volunteer at Least Once a Month

Volunteering is the perfect tool to develop a new skill, to discover a new talent and make new friends. It is never too late to realize new skills or accumulate knowledge. Volunteering brings together a diverse range of people with varied backgrounds. Both the recipients of your volunteer efforts and your fellow volunteers can be a valuable source of inspiration. Volunteering is about sharing your time, energy, and skills generously. "But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant." - Matthew 23:11 NKJV

3. Tell Others What God Has Done For You

People have a hard time witnessing; they don't know enough of the Bible and become quickly intimidated. The best way to tell a person about Jesus is to tell them what God has done for you in your life. If they try to get into a "theology battle" just say, "I don't know about all of that, but let me tell you what God has done for me...how he changed me, how he provided for me, how you have peace in your life and family that you've never experienced before." Nobody can argue what God has done for you in your life! It's about touching a hurting world with the love of Jesus Christ.

4. Attend Mid-Week Service

Ask yourself this question, "Where do I want to be one year from now?" You need a mid-week refueling. When coals of a fire are separated, the fire goes out...but coals that are together stay hot. If one year from now you expect to be somewhere different in your life, you need to make changes today. The best change you can make is to stay close to your church family, stay focused on your Spiritual Growth and watch how God works in your life!

5. Become a Member of Grace Unlimited

When you become a Member, it raises your level of commitment. The Church is about growing up in Christ. As a member, you become a participator and a contributor to your church family...and people know they can count on you. The members of the church are supposed to care for each other and pray for each other. How can they do that if they don't know who "each other" are? The leaders of the church are supposed to care for the church. How can they do that if they don't know who "the church" is. Become a part of something bigger than yourself.

6. Successful People are Readers

"A wise man is strong, yes, a man of knowledge increases strength;" - (Proverbs 24:5 NKJV) If you want to increase in power, you have to increase in knowledge. Successful people are readers. Set a goal of reading at least one book a month. Successful people do what unsuccessful people are not willing to do, and that often means living outside the limits of one's comfort zone.

7. Start a Bible Reading Program

If you will spend just 30 minutes a day spending time with God and reading His Word, you will read through the entire Bible in only 6 months. Find a quiet place in your home where you can lock in with God and watch how you grow!

8. Become a Tither

The point of living is giving. God wants each of us to live a life of giving. Giving is not just about money; it's an attitude of being generous in your time and the spirit of your giving. When we leave this earth, we take nothing with us...by giving, you have the power to touch and change lives.

MY CONFESSION OF FAITH

What does God want me to do?

1. **ADMIT** that God has not been first place in your life and ask Him to forgive your sins.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from every wrong." 1 John 1:9

2. **BELIEVE** that Jesus died to pay for your sins and that He rose again on Resurrection Sunday and is alive today.

"If you confess that Jesus is your Lord, and you believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9

"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name (Jesus) by which we must be saved." Acts 4:12

3. **ACCEPT** God's free gift of salvation. Don't try to earn it.

"For it is by grace you are saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God — not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8,9

4. **ASK** Jesus Christ to come into your life and be the Lord of your life.

"To all who receive Him, He gives the right to become children of God. All we need to do is to trust Him to save us. All those who believe this are reborn! "Not a physical rebirth...but from the will of God!" John 1:12-13

You can take these steps by praying a simple prayer of commitment to God:

"Dear Jesus, thank you for making me and loving me, even when I've ignored you and gone my own way. I realize I need you in my life and I'm sorry for my sins. I ask you to forgive me. Thank you for dying on the cross for me. Please help me to understand it more. As much as I know how, I want to follow you from now on. Please come into my life and make me a new person inside. I accept your gift of salvation. Please help me to grow now as a Christian."

ABSOLUTELY! While we understand that many people look at the size and scope of ministry at Grace Unlimited and think that they can't possibly make a difference, the truth of the matter is that you can. WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A MEMBER

The difference between "attendees" and "members" can be summed up in one word: COMMITMENT!

An Attender is a consumer...A Member is a *contributor*. A church family helps you to mature.

At Grace Unlimited we recognize the need for a formal membership. We ask you to commit to membership for 4 reasons:

1. A Biblical Reason: Christ is committed to the church.
"...Christ loved the church, and he gave his life for it." Ephesians 5:25

2. A Cultural Reason: It is an antidote to our society.

We live in an age where very few want to be committed to anything...a job...a marriage...our country. This attitude has even produced a generation of "church shoppers and hoppers". Membership swims against the current of America's "consumer religion." It is an unselfish decision. Commitment always builds character.

3. A Practical Reason: It defines who can be counted on.

Every team must have a roster. Every school must have an enrollment. Every business has a payroll. Every army has an enlistment. Even our country takes a census and requires voter registration. Membership identifies our family.

4. A Personal Reason: It produces spiritual growth.

The New Testament places a major emphasis on the need for Christians to be accountable to each other for spiritual growth. You cannot be accountable when you're not committed to any specific church family.

What Is Expected of Me As a Member?

At Grace Unlimited, we never ask our members to do more than what the Bible clearly teaches. We only expect our members to do what the Bible expects every Christian to do. These responsibilities are spelled out in the Membership Covenant.
